

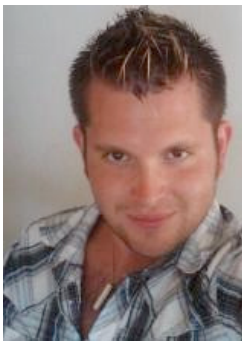
Guzmán's Dance Studio will be hosting a Dance Workshop Saturday January 14th, 2012

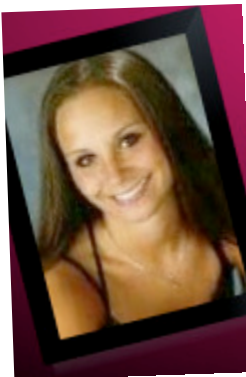

JESSE KATEN began studying dance in 1991 and has been teaching professionally since 2000, when he was named Student of the Year at The Dance Theater in Deposit, NY. He has placed First or Second at numerous dance competitions across the northeast and was the First Runner Up for the Mr. Dance of New York title in 2001. At age 19, he started his own studio, The Jesse Katen School of Dance, now in its eighth season at its new facility in downtown Binghamton, NY. A dance scholar as well as teacher, Jesse received his BA from Ithaca College and MA from Binghamton University, where he also taught as an adjunct professor. He is Artistic Director of the Jesse Katen Dance Company, a nonprofit public charity and has also served as Vice President of the Binghamton Chapter of the National Association of Dance. He currently maintains a busy travel schedule as a workshop teacher and competition

judge, adjudicating and teaching cities all over the United States, including the Sophisticated Productions Nationals in July of 2011. He shares his view on dance teaching, and technique on his blog at jessekaten.wordpress.com.



Miss Danae Bader is the owner and director of DMB Dance Productions. She has had 24 years of dance experience and began her professional dance career at age twelve. She toured across the United States performing in various shows in Las Vegas, Los Angeles, Lake Tahoe, NYC, and Chicago. Danae has also had the privilege of working with some of the most sought out instructors and choreographers such as Wade Robson, Brian Friedman, Laurie Ann Gibson, Mia Michaels, and Gus Gori-dano. Danae has had many experiences in her dance career. In 2003, she was chosen to perform at the Pro Bowl in Hawaii. She also performed on Fox TV's hit show, "So You Think You Can Dance" and was a member of an alternative jazz company in NYC. She has choreographed for many shows across the US including a showcase for a recording artist in Los Angeles. Danae also directed an inner city arts program

inspiring underprivileged youth in Newark, NJ. Currently, Danae travels across the country instructing master classes, choreographing for teams and shows, and is a staff member for a dance competition touring as a guest judge and instructor. Danae is a member of NYS Association for Health, Physical Education, Recreation and Dance (AHPERD). She instructs Hip Hop in PE classes for students in various grade levels across New York State.
